PHISHING ATTACKS

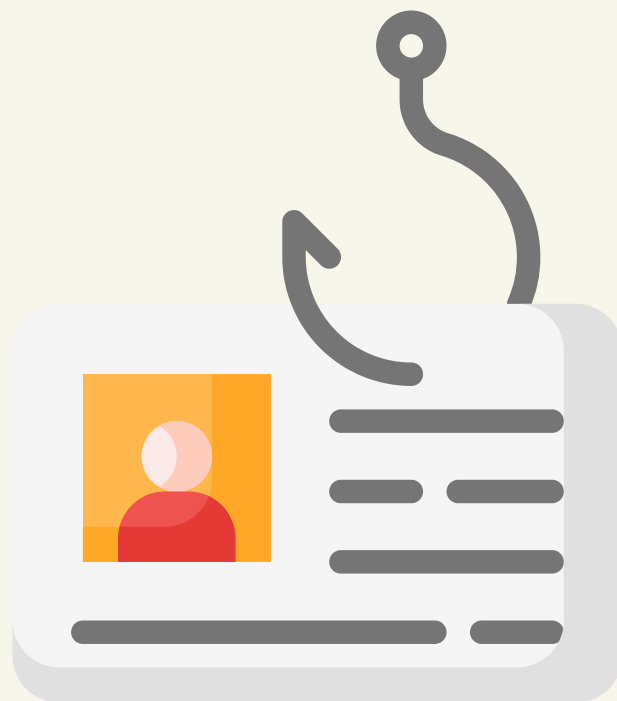
Phishing is a social engineering attack that used to steal personal data, such as login credentials and credit card numbers, by tricking users into sharing their private information.

Identity theft is an attack where criminals steal personal information and use it deceptively to purchase goods or services.

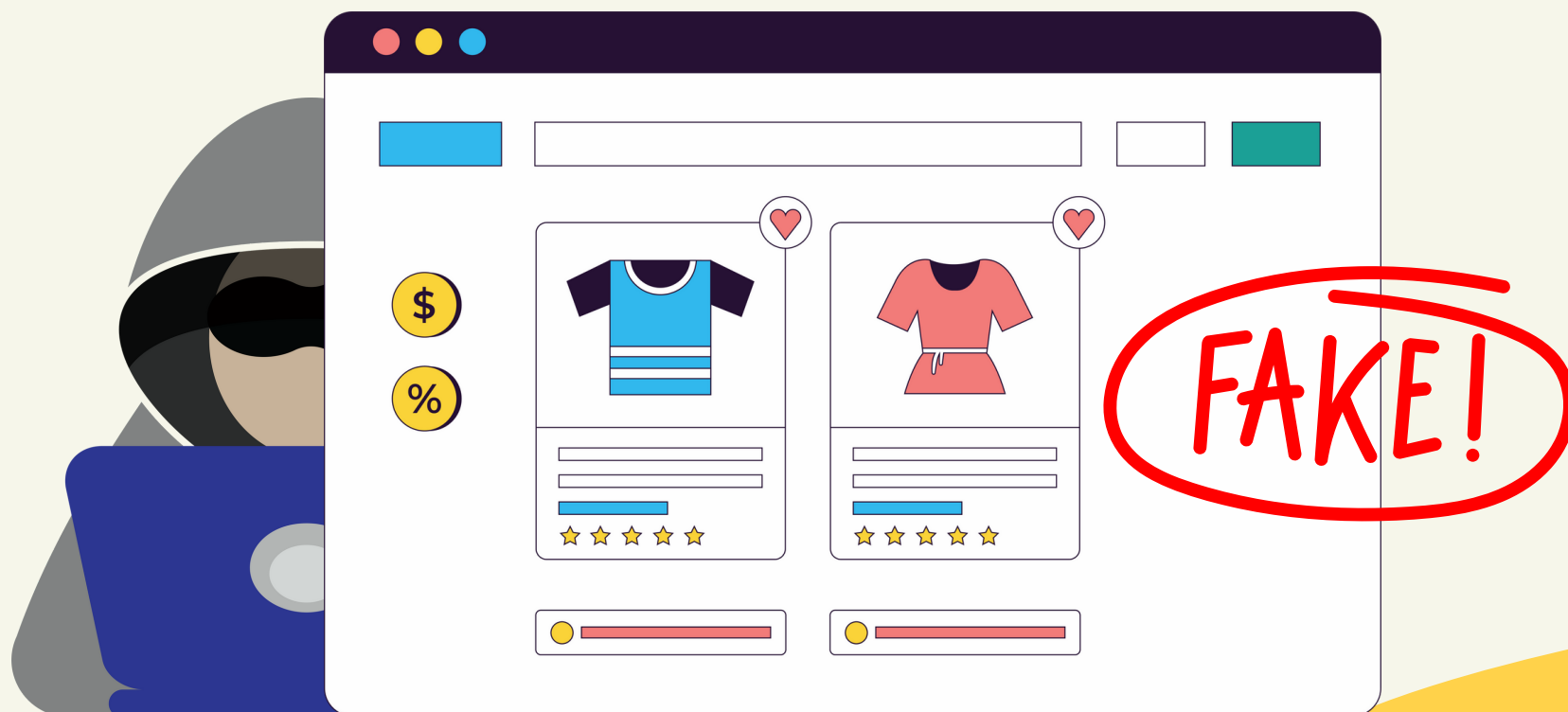
Often, fraudulent purchases happening this way would leave the victims very surprised.
